



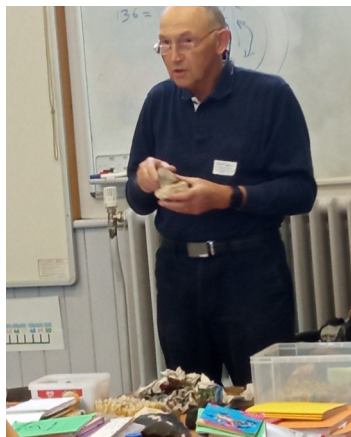
Holt Community Primary School Newsletter Autumn 4 2nd October 2023
