Curriculum Area	Learning Objective
Design and Technology	<p><u>MOVING PICTURES - moving parts (Moving Minibeasts)</u> Choose tools and equipment and explain their choices Plan what they will do next. Can talk about their design ideas and what they are making. Explore the movement of simple mechanisms such as levers, sliders. Use some technical vocabulary. Can explain how it will work</p>
English	Write animal myth
Science	<p>Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats. Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.</p>
