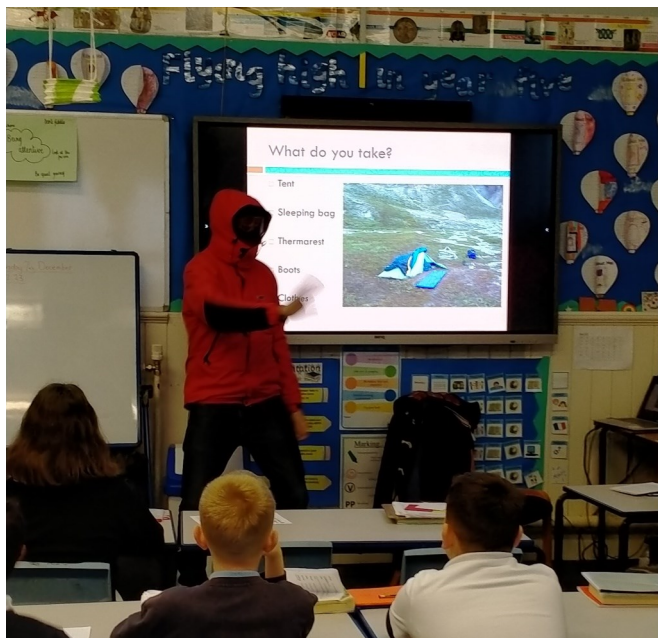




Holt Community Primary School Newsletter Autumn 13 11th December 2023
